CY Generations call



- <u>Goal</u>: solutions for sustainable innovation, to meet the challenges of ecological and societal transition
- <u>3 axes</u>: research, training, entrepreneurship
- <u>Partners</u>: CY Alliance, CNRS, CEREMA, LPI, Campus de la Transition, local authorities
- CY Generations call for research projects 2024 (2nd edition) budget 600 K€
 - Multidisciplinary, multi-laboratory research projects addressing at least one SDG
 - Perimeter: CY Alliance, CNRS, CEREMA, LPI
 - Programmes (articulated with the CY Initiative call)
 - Emergence
 - Horizon

Programmes

Common to CY Initiative and CY Generations

Possible double application to CY Initiative and CY Generations

EMERGENCE : Emerging research projects with high potential

- Small research team (at least 2 researchers)
- Preparing application to external funding
- Funding: 2 years, 25-50 K€
- Estimation : 10 projects funded (6 CY Initiative ; 4 CY Generations)
- HORIZON : Ambitious scientific projects in strategic research areas
 - Large research team, adapted to the scientific ambition of the project and able to build the research network
 - Preparing application to large-scale external funding (e.g. European)
 - Funding: 4 years, 150-200 K€
 - Estimation : 6 projects funded (4 CY Initiative ; 2 CY Generations)

Programmes

Only for CY Initiative

- TALENT : Recruitment of high-level young researchers
 - Funding: 3 years, 250-350 K€
 - High potential candidates: academic results, ambition and innovation of the project
 - 2 10 years of postdoctoral experience, outside CYU / ESSEC
 - Integration into the host lab strategy: attested by the lab director, project built with the hosting laboratory
 - Commitment to apply for additional external funding (ERC, etc.)
 - Estimation : 2 projects funded

- Final application: until 25 January 2024, 13:00 CET (mandatory)
- Results : May 2024
- Kick-off : early June 2024

Collaborative Exchanges: goals

- 2 stages of 2-week collaborative exchanges:
 - October: Partnership seeking (OPTIONAL)
 - December: <u>Open co-construction</u> of the project (MANDATORY for CYG / OPTIONNAL for CYI)
- Goals:
 - Promote collaboration and multidisciplinarity
 - Facilitate connections between researchers
 - Improve proposed projects

The Force is a metaphysical and ubiquitous power. People like the Jedi seek to "become one with the Force", matching their personal wills with the will of the Force, while the Sith exploit the Force and try to bend it toward their destructive desires.

Selection criteria

Scientific excellence criteria:

- The scientific quality and innovative character of the project, quality of the scientific team
- Development strategy, sustainability and impact
- Implementation

- Other factors considered :
 - PhD recruitment
 - External partnerships (without financing)
 - Other CEREMA units, CNRS laboratories, EUTOPIA partners, international strategic partners, IRD
 - CY Generations local authority partners

CY Generations specific criteria



- At least 2 research structures within CY Generations perimeter with significant contributions in the different fields
- Innovative contribution of multidisciplinarity and suitability of the disciplines brought together for the research project
- Relevance / impact of the research project to / on the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) targeted
 - SDGs highlighted by CY Generations:
 - repair and care (SDGs 3, 10, 16, 17);
 - produce and consume (SDG 17);
 - build and organize society (SDGs 8, 9, 11, 17);
 - promote solidarity and inclusive education (SDGs 1, 4, 5, 17)
 - Coherence of the proposed multidisciplinary approach with the challenged SDG

Review process



- 2 to 3 external, recognized disciplinary experts per project
- Multidisciplinary projects: experts for each discipline
- Step 2 : Scientific Committee for each call (April)
 - CY Initiative: 3 thematic committees (Modeling Sciences, Experimental Sciences, Social Sciences and Humanities) composed of external and internal personalities
 - CY Generations: external personalities experts on multidisciplinary and sustainable development aspects
 - 2 to 3 evaluators per project
 - Result: Ranked list of projects proposed for funding + complementary list
- Final decision by the Steering committee of CY Generations & the Executive Board of CY Initiative (early May)

Emergence : will projects < 25k€ be considered or is this a strict minimum?	There is no strict minimum for any programme. You can ask for <25k€ for an EMERGENCE programme
for EMERGENCE : are internships and equipment eligible? If yes, is there a limiting percentage of the overall budget?	for EMERGENCE : are internships and equipment eligible? If yes, is there a limiting percentage of the overall budget?
Where can I find the salary bracket to be accounted for in the application for a TALENT program?	For the salary, you can accounted around 160k€ for the 3years. For more details, you need to contact the administrative & financial service (email is in the call text, depending on your institution: service.valorisation@cyu.fr/brookman@essec.edu)
For the budget constitution, who should we contact, please ?	You need to contact the administrative & financial service of your institution (email is in the call text, depending on your institution)
could we clarify how we register and get access for the projects' platform?	Follow this link: <u>https://generations.cy.projets.app/register/67b10940-ed33-4161-</u> b145-40f9986b2a82
can we have the list of CEREMA centers eligible please?	CEREMA centres eligible: ENDSUM, TEAM, STI, GéoCoD, EL, MCD
Is the project must be written in English?	It is preferable for us, but not mandatory. Only projects in English can be reviewed by international experts
Can projects include partners from other countries/labs? Including outside EUTOPIA?	Yes, external partners can come from anywhere, but they cannot receive funds
Are researchers of a joint research unit with CY University eligible for CY Initiatives? Or does it depend on the partner institute?	Researcher must be part of a CY Initiative Institution (CYU, ESSEC, CNRS) AND an elibible lab. If not, the researcher is considered as external partner and cannont receive funds.
